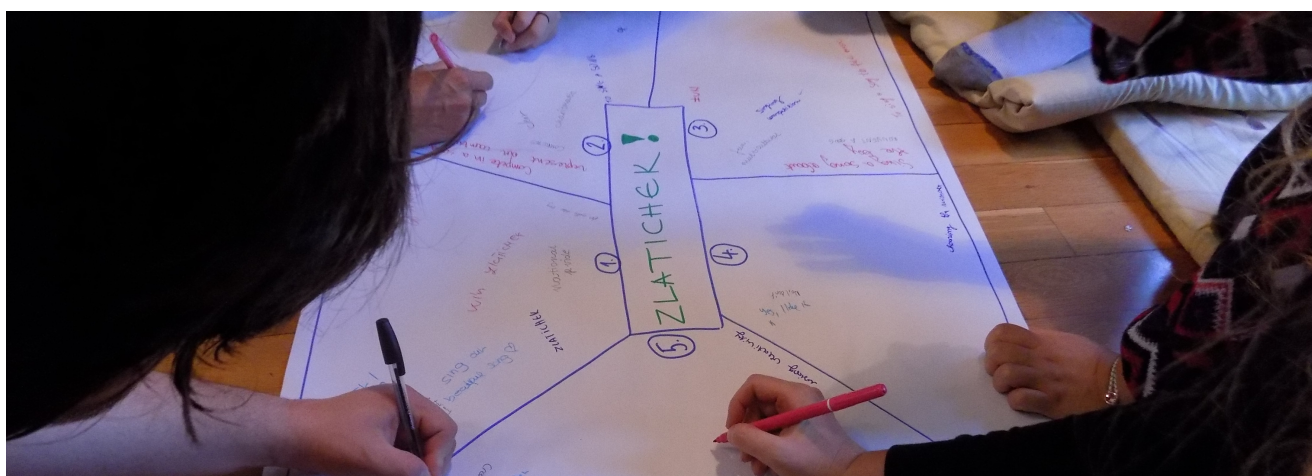

Here you will meet participants from Finland, Spain, Estonia, Slovakia, and the Czech Republic

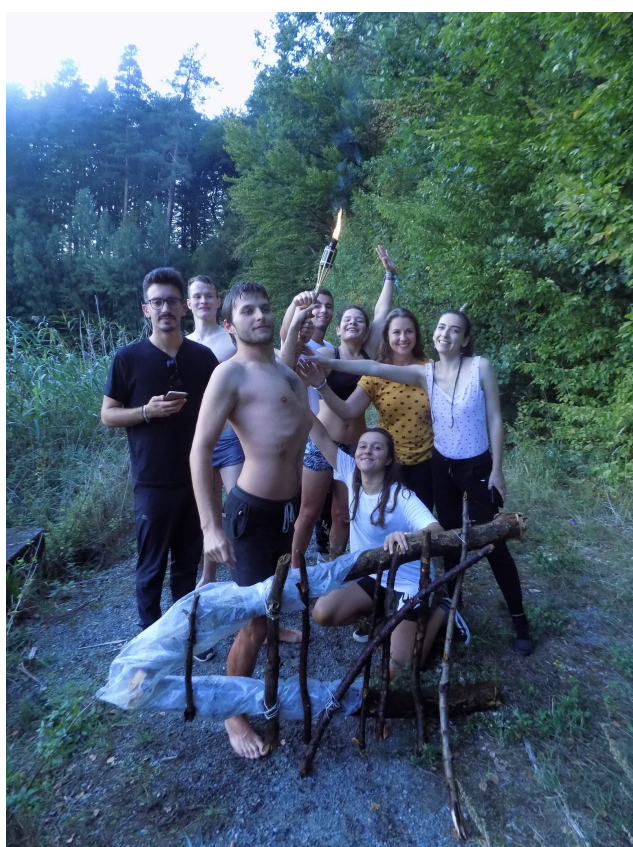

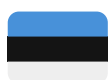
interested in experiential pedagogy and non-formal education. The project is designed both for the beginners and those who already have some experiences in this area. Thus, we start with the basics.

All the other details will be explained while discussing your ticket arrangements. **Please, do not buy any tickets without our confirmation and do not hesitate to let us now for any of your questions.** The participants are responsible to choose the cheapest possible connections. In addition, we kindly ask you to avoid short haul flights (<600 km). The travel costs will be reimbursed according to Erasmus+ program rules

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About Reimbursements and Coverage

- **Please do not buy any tickets without our confirmation.**
- Please note that you will be reimbursed only after providing us with all of your original tickets and boarding passes.
- Travel costs, accommodation, program, and food will be covered from the Erasmus+ grant.
- We are able to travel your travel costs only up to the limit based on the Erasmus+ rules and only from/to your home country (*e.g. a Finnish participant can be reimbursed only for travel to and from Finland only, other destinations are not accepted*).
- Please note, that we will not be reimbursing you for the travel insurance.



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What to Bring?

The venue is in a village (*Malá Morávka*) so it is surrounded by beautiful nature. Please take some sporty clothes and some old clothes that might get dirty.
