Erasmus+ training course is an educational program that brings together youth workers, educators, and young people from various countries to enhance their skills, exchange knowledge, and strengthen collaboration.

These courses include interactive activities like workshops, discussions, and group projects that promote non-formal learning and active engagement.

The goal is to equip participants with tools and methods they can use in their work with young people and within their organizations.



All participants will receive a **Youthpass certificate** as a recognition of their participation and learning during the project.



Aim

Soil to Society project aims to strengthen youth workers' capacity to address sustainable agriculture as an integral part of environmental youth work.

Objectives

- Understand the connections between agriculture, climate change, and biodiversity.
- Exchange international perspectives on sustainable agriculture.
- Learn non-formal methods for environmental education.
- Improve communication on sustainable agriculture.
- Inspire practical actions and community initiatives supporting sustainable agriculture.

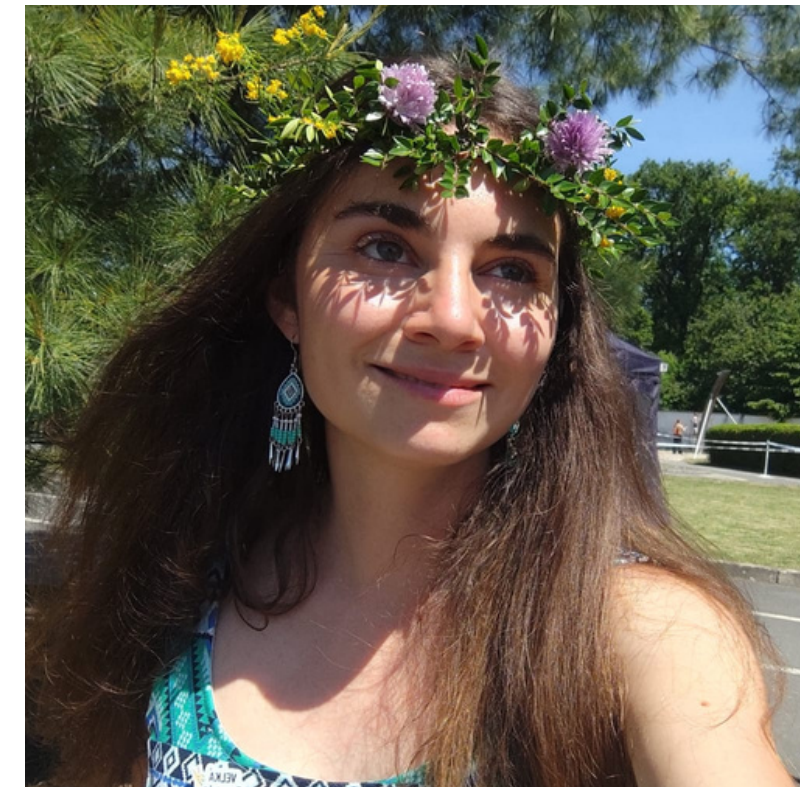


Meet the team

How to get to Rašov



✈️ If flying, we recommend flights to Vienna, Prague or Bratislava. Take a bus from airport to **Brno**, it takes approx. 2-3 hours.

Green travel (train/bus) is encouraged and prioritized. There are many international Flixbus/Regiojet buses that go directly to Brno.

🚆 From Brno, there is a direct train to **Tišnov**.

🚗 Group transfer from Tišnov to Rašov will be organised by the hosting team.

Travel reimbursement

Travel costs will be fully reimbursed after the project, provided that participants:

- Submit all travel tickets and invoices.
- Organise a dissemination workshop in their local community after returning.
- Support their sending organisation with sharing the project's outcomes.

Participants from Türkiye who require a visa will receive an additional 90 EUR to cover visa costs.



Travel insurance

All participants must have valid travel insurance covering the entire stay in Czechia.

Make sure your insurance covers medical care and personal liability (min. €500,000)

Please note that for participants from Ukraine and Türkiye, the proof of insurance can be requested by the Czech authorities.

Participants from EU countries need to **bring their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).**
